**TEXT for Today:**

**Jude 1:20-25**

**20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, 21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. 22 And of some have compassion, making a difference: 23 And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh. 24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, 25 To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.**

The meaning of this word:

Deconstruction is the process of questioning, doubting, and ultimately rejecting aspects of the Christian faith.

Jude 1:25 To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

This verse is a reminder that God has the attributes, the position, and the legitimate right to get you through whatever challenges confront you and the moral decay in the world around you.

**WE MUST KNOW:**

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of our faith.
  - a. Jude 1:21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
  - b. Hebrews 11:1-3 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. 2 For by it the elders obtained a good testimony. 3 By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the .
  - c. New Testament meaning of “word” first is \_\_\_\_\_. Inspired Word of God and Jesus, the Living Word.
  - d. New Testament meaning of “word” second is \_\_\_\_\_. Which refers to the spoken Word.
  - e. What you can’t \_\_\_\_\_ said something, and something became \_\_\_\_\_.
  - f. Romans 5:1-2 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
  - g. Jesus becomes our \_\_\_\_\_ in all of life—what we look to.

**WE MUST KNOW:**

2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of our faith.
  - a. Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

- b. Author and finisher of our faith is out to \_\_\_\_\_ us.
- c. Philippians 1:6 being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

Jude 1:24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

**WE MUST KNOW:**

3. The \_\_\_\_\_ of our faith.
- a. Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
- b. Jude 1:22-23 And of some have compassion, making a difference: 23 And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.
- c. 1 Peter 1:3-9 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, 5 who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 6 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, 7 that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, 8 whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, 9 receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of your souls.

**Conclusion:**

**Jesus must be the object of our faith!**

**Jesus must be the developer of our faith!**

**Doing what Jesus leads us to do becomes the significance of our faith!**
